ORDINANCE NO. 12-005

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HOLTON, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES," EDITION OF 2012; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 11-002.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HOLTON, KANSAS:

Section 1. INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE: There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Holton, Kansas, that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code" Edition 2012, prepared and published by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance 12-005," and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at reasonable hours.


Section 2. REPEAL: Ordinance No. 11-002 is hereby repealed.


Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official newspaper.
