ORDINANCE NO. 13-001

AN ORDINANCE CREATING SECTION 7-314 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF HOLTON, KANSAS, BANNING THE USE AND SALE OF WIRE HANDLED SPARKLERS AND SKY LANTERNS IN THE CITY LIMITS OF HOLTON, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HOLTON, KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 7-314 of the Municipal Code of the City of Holton, Kansas is hereby created to read as follows:

"7-314 USE AND SALE OF WIRE HANDLED SPARKLERS AND SKY LANTERNS."


(a) It is unlawful for any person(s) to sell and/or light wire handled sparklers or sky lanterns within the city limits of the City of Holton.

Section 2. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall be included in the Municipal Code of the City of Holton and shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication, or a summary thereof, in the official newspaper.
