ORDINANCE NO. 15-006

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ELECTRIC CONNECTION PERMIT FEES FOR THE CITY OF HOLTON, KANSAS, BY AMENDING HOLTON CITY CODE CHAPTER 15, ARTICLE 3, SECTION 15-302 AND 15-303, RELATING TO SERVICE CONNECTIONS; PERMIT REQUIRED AND FEES AND SERVICE CONNECTIONS AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1204 AND 1222.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HOLTON, KANSAS:

Section 1. Chapter 15, Article 3, Section 15-302 and 15-303, of the Code of the City of Holton relating to service connections; permit required and fees and service connections is hereby amended as follows:

15-302 SERVICE CONNECTIONS; PERMIT REQUIRED AND FEES. (a) Any person, firm or corporation desiring to connect to the city electric system shall make application for a permit to do so. The application shall be in writing, signed by the owner, or his or her authorized agent, of the property with which the connection is to be made.
(b) Connection Permit Fees. The applicant for a service connection permit shall pay to the City Clerk a fee for such permit in accordance with the following schedule:

Single Phase: Service connection fees shall be in the amount of \$75.00 per 100 amp. of service size.

Three Phase: Service connection fees shall be in the amount of \$100.00 per 100 amp. of service size.

15-303 SERVICE CONNECTIONS.
(a) Overhead Services.

Single Phase: All costs of material incurred over the amount of \$1,200.00 will be the sole responsibility of the home and or the business owner.

Three Phase: All costs of materials incurred over the amount of \$3,000.00 will be the sole responsibility of the home and or business owner.

The city will supply the meter and meter box. If a yard pole (one) is necessary, the city will supply the pole as well. The building wiring, breaker box, and service entrance shall be provided and installed at the

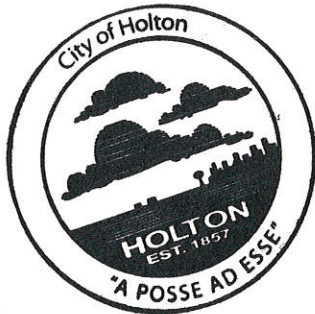
expense of the owner. The city shall be responsible for the care and maintenance of the wiring and apparatus from the service entrance to the city's power lines and the meter and all wiring and equipment installed by the city shall remain the property of the city.


(b) Underground Service Installation. On all underground services, the city shall supply the meter, meter box, install all primary lines and transformer. The owner shall be responsible for the secondary line and installation from the transformer to the service entrance, including all building wire and breaker box. All wiring and equipment installed by the city shall remain the property of the city.

Section 2. REPEAL. This ordinance repeals Ordinance No. 1222 and 1204, and that no other provisions, terms, or conditions of the Code of the City of Holton are amended or repealed by this ordinance.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official newspaper with the fees to become effective after June 1, 2015.
