ORDINANCE NO. 16-006

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE No. 1203 WHICH IS THE CITY OF HOLTON'S COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE TO EXPAND THE USES PERMITTED IN A INDUSTRIAL PARK DISTRICT.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HOLTON, KANSAS:**

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 1203 is hereby amended specifically as it pertains to Article XVI "I-P" Industrial Park District Section 3 Use Regulations. An additional permitted use of medical clinic shall be added as number 20 to read as follows:

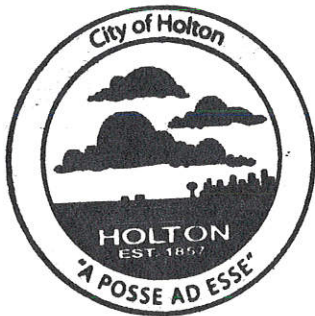
"20. Medical Clinic."

Section 2. That no other provisions, terms or conditions as contained in Ordinance 1203 and amendments thereto are changed or repealed by this ordinance except those listed above.

Section 3. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication, or a summary thereof, in the official newspaper.

On April 18, 2016, the governing body of the City of Holton, Kansas passed an ordinance entitled:
