

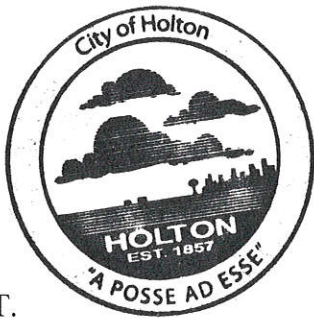

ORDINANCE NO. 19-006

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 3-104 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF
HOLTON WHICH PROHIBITED CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR UPON
PUBLIC STREETS**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HOLTON,
KANSAS:**

- Section 1. That KSA 41-719 has been amended to allow for consumption of alcoholic liquor upon public streets during special events when a temporary permit for such has been approved by the city and the state.
- Section 2. That Section 3-104 of the city code, which prohibits consumption of alcoholic liquor on public streets, was enacted in conformance with the state law governing alcoholic liquor prior to the amendments allowing for consumption on public streets.
- Section 3. That Section 3-104 of the city code is hereby repealed.
- Section 4. That all state laws governing consumption of alcoholic liquor upon public streets and issuance of temporary permits shall be applicable within the city.
- Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication, or a summary thereof, in the official newspaper.
