ORDINANCE NO. 19-007

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE 16-001 REGARDING TERM OF OFFICE FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS AND PROVIDING THAT OFFICIALS ELECTED AT A NOVEMBER GENERAL ELECTION SHALL TAKE OFFICE AT THE FIRST MEETING OF THE GOVERNING BODY IN DECEMBER, FOLLOWING CERTIFICATION OF THE ELECTION

WHEREAS, the 2015 Kansas Legislature enacted L. 2015, Chapter 88, House Bill 2104 mandating new terms for the Governing Body and provided that newly elected officials would take office on the second Monday in January; and,

WHEREAS, the 2019 Kansas Legislature enacted Senate Bill 105 which provides that officials elected at a November general election may take office at the first meeting of the governing body in December after certification of the election but no later than the second Monday in January following certification of the election; and,

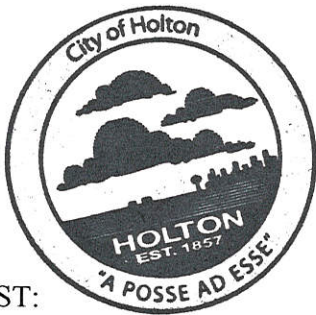
WHEREAS, the governing body desires for officials elected in a November general election to take office at the first meeting of the governing body in December after certification of the election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HOLTON, KANSAS:

Section 2: GOVERNING BODY; NOVEMBER ELECTIONS. Officials elected at a November general election shall take office at the first meeting of December following certification of the election.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
