

MINUTES OF THE MAY 20, 2013 CITY COMMISSION MEETING

The regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Holton met at 7:00 P.M. in City Hall on Monday evening, May 20, 2013. Commissioners Tim Morris, Hal Cochren, Erich Campbell and Dan Brenner were present. Mayor Bob Dieckmann called the meeting to order.

Minutes of the May 6, 2013 meeting were approved with corrections.

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE: Claims against the City of Holton between May 7, 2013 and May 20, 2013, were presented to the Commission for their approval. After careful consideration, said claims were approved and given the title Appropriation Ordinance #2085. Hal Cochren moved and Erich Campbell seconded the motion for their approval. Vote thereon: all, yes.

COMPRESSION BRAKE SYSTEMS: Bret Bauer, City Manager, presented his research on compression brake systems to the commission. We can intervene on this by Section 175.1 of the 2012 Standard Traffic Ordinance. We can also request the county coordinate with us to request KDOT signage on US Highway 75. Bauer will get with KDOT.

In other business:

The questions was raised of meeting with the Jackson County Commission to discuss issues pertinent to both. After some discussion, it was decided that the city would send a representative over to the county commission meetings on their first meeting of the month to meet with commissioners on any questions that may need to be addressed.

Opening Day for the Holton Municipal Swimming Pool will be May 25, 2013 with a free swim day. Drew Porter was introduced as the new pool manager.
