

MINUTES OF THE JUNE 1, 2015 CITY COMMISSION MEETING

The regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Holton met at 7:00 P.M. in City Hall on Monday evening, June 1, 2015. Commissioners Tim Morris, Twila White, Erich Campbell and Dan Brenner were present. Mayor Bob Dieckmann was also present.

Mayor Dieckmann called the regular meeting to order.

Minutes of the May 18, 2015 meeting were approved as written.

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE: Claims against the City of Holton between May 19, 2015 and June 1, 2015, were presented to the Commission for their approval. After careful consideration, said claims were approved and given the title Appropriation Ordinance #2136. Tim Morris moved and Dan Brenner seconded the motion for their approval. Vote thereon: all, yes.

PROCLAMATION: The American Legion Auxiliary has asked the city to proclaim the day of June, 2015 as Poppy Day. This is a great honor and a way to support our veteran and current military personnel serving in the Armed Forces. Mayor Bob Dieckmann read a proclamation designating June 13, 2015 as Poppy Day

Dan Brenner told the commission he had a citizen ask him why we couldn't go on down Wisconsin while we are doing the current brick project and fix curb. He said he explained that roads are graded and done in the order of fixing the worst first.

Twila White had a citizen ask about if a yield or stop sign could be installed at 5th and Illinois. She commented that the county yard is right there and that intersection does see quite a bit of traffic. Bret Bauer, City Manager, said he would let the Street Superintendent Rex Cameron know of the concern and have him take a look at it.

Bob Dieckmann asked Assistant City Manager Kerwin McKee to look into some mattresses that have been sitting by the road on 5th Street for several weeks. McKee said he would look into it.

Erich Campbell wanted to that the VFW and American Legion personnel who did an excellent job on Memorial Day. On another note, he wanted to the city to be aware that the American Legion is trying to raise approximately \$20,000 for a Purple Heart Memorial. He believe that they are looking at possibly placing it in Linscott Park by the other veterans memorial.

Bret Bauer informed the commission that he had been notified by Waste Management that they have merged with Deffenbaugh Disposal. They are planning to change the pickup days in Holton from two days to one and that day will be Wednesday. They are going to be issuing a press release to inform the citizens of the day change.

Dan Brenner moved to go into executive session for 25 minutes for non elected personnel. Twila White seconded the motion. Vote thereon: all; yes. After 25 minutes Dan Brenner moved to return to regular session. Tim Morris seconded the motion. Vote thereon: all; yes.
