

MINUTES OF THE DECEMBER 4, 2017 CITY COMMISSION MEETING

The City Commission of the City of Holton met at 7:00 p.m. in City Hall on Monday evening, December 4, 2017. Commissioners Twila White, Mike Meerpohl, Tim Morris and Dan Brenner were present. Mayor Bob Dieckmann was also present.

Mayor Bob Dieckmann called the regular meeting to order.

Minutes of the November 20, 2017 meeting were approved as written.

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE: Claims against the City of Holton between November 21, 2017 and December 4, 2017 were presented to the commission for their approval. After careful consideration, said claims were approved and given the title Appropriation Ordinance 2197. Tim Morris made the motion and Dan Brenner seconded the motion for their approval. Vote thereon: all; yes.

FIRST MEETING IN JANUARY: With the new election laws, newly elected or reelected commissioners must be sworn in on the second Monday in January. Since we normally meeting on the first Monday, we will need to move the January 1 meeting to January 8. Dan Brenner made a motion to move the January 1 meeting to January 8 at 7:00 p.m. Mike Meerpohl seconded the motion. Vote thereon: all; yes.

Tim Morris asked when the Christmas dinner would be. Kerwin McKee, City Manager, said it would be planned for December 22.

Dan Brenner relayed a citizen question he received about whether it damages the street sweeper to sweep the chip and seal streets and pick up all that rock. McKee said he would check. He also told the commissioners that the burn site is now closed until approximately April 1.
