

MINUTES OF THE SEPTEMBER 4, 2018 CITY COMMISSION MEETING

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE: Claims against the City of Holton between August 21, 2018 and September 4, 2018 were presented to the commission for their approval. After careful consideration, said claims were approved and given the title Appropriation Ordinance 2216. Mike Meerpohl moved and Dan Brenner seconded the motion for their approval. NEIGHBORHOOD BARBEQUE: A request has been received by the residents of the 800 block of Iowa to hold a neighborhood barbeque on September 30 from 4–9 p.m.. They would like to block the road during the party. Dan Brenner made a motion to approve the request. Twila White seconded the motion. Vote thereon: all; yes.

WASTEWATER PLANT AWARD: Kansas Water Environment Association (KWEA) has awarded the City of Holton Wastewater Treatment Plant as the Class 3 Plant of the Year for 2018. This award has been received by the City six times in the last eleven years.

Kerwin McKee, City Manager, asked for permission to seek bids on a new police car. This is in the police budget this year. Commissioners agreed to allow him to go out for bids.
