MINUTES OF THE NOVEMBER 15, 2010 CITY COMMISSION MEETING

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE: Claims against the City of Holton between November 1, 2010 and November 15, 2010, were presented to the Commission for their approval. After careful consideration, said claims were approved and given the title Appropriation Ordinance #2023. Tim Morris moved and Bob Dieckmann seconded the motion for their approval.
