

MINUTES OF THE SEPTEMBER 20, 2010 CITY COMMISSION MEETING

The regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Holton met at 7:00 P.M. in City Hall on Monday evening, September 20, 2010. Commissioners Tim Morris and Bob Dieckmann were present. JJ Cashier and Janet Zwonitzer were absent. Mayor Rich Mulroy called the meeting to order.

Minutes of the September 7, 2010 meeting were approved as written

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE: Claims against the City of Holton between September 8, 2010 and September 20, 2010, were presented to the Commission for their approval. After careful consideration, said claims were approved and given the title Appropriation Ordinance #2019. Tim Morris moved and Bob Dieckmann seconded the motion for their approval. Vote thereon: all, yes.

ORDINANCE 10-005 ELECTRICAL INTERCONNECTION STANDARDS: Ordinance 10-005 setting standards, procedures, agreements, charges and fees for electrical interconnection were presented to the commission. The ordinance is required for participation in the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC). Bob Dieckmann moved to approve ordinance 10-005. Tim Morris seconded the motion. Vote thereon: all; yes.

ORDINANCE 10-006 NET METERING: Ordinance 10-006 for net metering was also presented to the commission. Net metering goes along with the interconnection ordinance Bob Dieckmann moved to approve Ordinance 10-006. Tim Morris seconded the motion. Vote thereon: all; yes.

In other business:

Bret Bauer, City Manager, informed the commission that if the weather holds, the street department would begin work on curb and gutter at the Industrial Park. Pool attendance figures were also presented. The total generated for admissions and concessions this year was \$30,989.40.

Bauer commended everyone involved in the military funeral on September 18. Everyone worked together to make the day go smoothly.
